Introduction

The lockdown caused by the Covid-19 pandemic has changed the conduct of society and introduced new risks in the healthcare sector. The continuous process of innovation in advanced technologies and the introduction of artificial intelligence have had a greater impact on the new model of the healthcare sector. Covid-19 risks and the management of emerging healthcare processes have made it essential to consider the new healthcare model, i.e. Healthcare 5.0.

Automation and Artificial Intelligence (AI) are two booming concepts of healthcare 5.0 that are set to revolutionise the workplaces. AI in Healthcare 5.0 covers the concept of accurate and automated disease prediction diagnosis; remote patient monitoring and treatment; surgical robots. Recent advances in smart healthcare, such as emerging 5G technology, edge computing, interconnected Internet of Things (IoT) devices, and data analytics, have enabled integrated healthcare services.

- As the Chief Executive Officer, he steered Apollo Hospitals, Hyderabad to be the first hospital in the region to be accredited by Joint Commission International, USA and the first hospital outside the United States of America to be certified for excellence in management of acute stroke once again by Joint Commission International.
- Though his busy schedule he also published a book called 'I AM POSSIBLE'.
- He served as a Member Healthcare Sub-Committee of CII Southern Region for the year 2015-16 & current active CII Council Member for the year 2019-2020.

Points discussed:

- Initiated the talk about 'PPP Public Private Partnership'. According to Dr. Prasad there aren't many successful models in the country due to the lack of involvement of the 4th 'P' i.e. Public. According to him unless the public are involved the models aren't successful.
- For the success of any model all the public and the stakeholders are to be aligned interests have to be aligned and the outcomes have impact all of them positively. In healthcare the prominent stakeholder is the common man (public). Next the speaker highlighted on 5th 'P' that is Policy making should be consistent and encouraged. They need to be inclusive goals and outcome oriented.
- Further he highlighted on "Preventive Medicine" and its importance
- Suggests on moving away from transactional medicine and transactional care to programmatic medicine and connected care
- Improved technology leads newer models of care evolving and leads to more Connected care
- Teleconsultation and Home healthcare models and many newer models are evolving and is here to stay as it bring lots of advantages
- Highlighted on severe shortages on intensivists and E-ICU
- Simulation techniques for surgeons brings in a lot of benefits for surgeons, Artificial Intelligence and 3D Printing have huge scope in future, Genetic synthesis and Genetic modification are also emerging in the healthcare

- Dr. Prasad quotes that "Chane is inevitable, anyone who is going to resist change is going to perish and anyone who promotes the change is going to achieve great success in healthcare sector.
- According to Dr. Prasad all the healthcare professionals should be digitally savvy because
 everything is going to be digitalized from admission to the discharge to measuring patient
 satisfaction to measuring clinical outcomes to making sure that your delivering evidencebased medicine to making sure that your clinical pathways are implemented to HR
 processes to a procurement process everything is digitise now and you are in a paperless
 world. So to meet all the requirements healthcare professionals should be digitally savvy.
- One of the big challenges that India is facing today is Geographical access to healthcare services because almost 95 to 96% of the good health care facilities are limited to only 5% of the geography of the country. Where the rest 95% of the geography of the country is facing problem in accessing the healthcare services.
- Next major challenge is that quality healthcare services is costlier. Improved technology input tools for diagnosis and treatments also increases expenses on healthcare. Due to this a significant 80% of the population of the country couldn't afford this quality care
- So overall there is a major challenge for the country in terms of geographical access and financial access of healthcare services.
- So all policies need to address these two challenges in terms of ensuring that the people in remote areas in tier 2 and tier 3 and rural areas have access to quality care and digital networks using hub and spoke models using policies to attract investment in these areas to improve geographical access to healthcare services.
- Similarly, to address financial access, A mandatory health insurance is the only solution. A mandatory universal Health insurance is only way forward for creating a financial access to people who are not able to afford quality care today.

- An explanation on the decisive parameters that are critical for choosing a hospital from patient's perceived quality of care. These parameters comprise of location (18%), reputation of hospital (20%), physicians' decision (21%) and patient experience (41%).
- He described the major factors affecting patient experience. It included staff behaviour, clinical skillsets and outcomes, communication, quantum of waiting time, comfort through infrastructure and ambience and customer relationship management.
- It was followed by a detailed depiction of 5 innovations to create patient loyalty. He explained about:
 - Card game of Rotterdam Eye Hospital that encouraged team members to know each other, enhanced information sharing between staff members and increased patient safety scores.
 - o Advances in Patient Feedback Systems Digital feedback forms and online assessment of patient experience scores
 - o Artificial Intelligence enabled patient's virtual assistants and chatbots
 - o Continued Communication enabling patient's journey mapping and guiding them through the same
 - o Mobile Apps for the management of chronic patients thereby facilitating information, education and communication.






