Ms. Rini Philip, Member of the Academic committee, MBA-HHM, performed the welcome speech.



### **Points discussed**

- ✓ Data provided:-
  - Indian Healthcare sector is expected to reach Rs 19, 56,920 crore (US \$ 280 billion) by 2020.
  - Gross direct premium income in health insurance grew by 17.1% year to year to Rs 12,443.48 crore (US \$ 1.78 billion) in financial year 2020.
  - The sector is expected to generate 40 million jobs in India by 2030.
  - The amount of investment and job opportunities in healthcare industry is enormous.
  - Healthcare industry in India is projected to reach \$ 372 billion by 2020.
  - The Hospital industry in India, accounting for 80% of the total healthcare market growing at a CAGR of 16-17%
  - The Indian Medical Tourism is expected to grow from \$ 3 billion to \$ 7-8 billion by 2020.
  - The diagnostic industry in India currently valued at \$4 billion.
  - The primary care industry is currently valued at \$13 billion.
- ✓ As being a Healthcare manager we need to look for the 2 combination of the following 3 treatment i.e. fast, good and cheap.
- ✓ Issues faced are the rising healthcare costs, fulfilling patient expectations, coping with the new market entrants and technology ecosystem.
- ✓ The healthcare stakeholders are the one who is working in the hospitals need to invest in value based care, advance digital technologies (like electronic medical records), data interoperability (where we need to know the demographics of the market and also track of patients in paediatric and ICU department and do the analysis of it for better outcome) and this could build a smart health ecosystem.
- ✓ Operational excellence, which will be the critical in the next normal because of prolonged revenue growth and the expenditure for PPE, masks and sanitizations during this covid has increased and to minimize that cost will be a great challenge.
- ✓ Enablers have to adjust to the next normal like the technological advancements during this covid era we need to expand the software and trainings is given to the nurses and doctors regarding this advancements, greater flexibility in reimbursement model, consumer adoption on the basis of safety and preventive aspects and many new government laws like insurance will change post covid.
- ✓ Operations management is utilizing the resources like man power, machines, infrastructure to cultivate the best outcome which in hospital means the best recovery of the patient and efficiency but at the minimum cost.
- ✓ Example of operation management is that first we gain knowledge during our 2 years of management in hospital course, then we go to our job to gain experience based on our knowledge we received and by that experience and knowledge we become more creative like running the department with lesser cost and for the best outcome.



- ✓ Healthcare professional need to get a handle on operations because at minimum they enable in running the business. Strategic planning in healthcare organization involves outlining the actionable steps which are needed to reach specific goals. It is important as being a healthcare professional to know the Mission and Vision of the hospitals.
- ✓ Operations in the hospitals include the staff management where medical staff scheduling is done, financial management of patients billing and insurance, practice optimization includes healthcare analytics and risk management and at last the compliance management which has the laws and healthcare credentials.
- ✓ Operation management is all about structure, process and outcome. For example, any department in hospital we have to utilize the structure in such a way with the help of define processes to ensure an efficient outcome.
- ✓ Prominent example of operations management in healthcare include controlling costs and improving the quality of services provided to patients.
- ✓ For a healthcare system to function efficiently, necessary aspects include generous financing, a well -trained and well-paid workforce, credible information on which policies can be structured and health facilities that are well-maintained and reliably managed.

We had a brief Question and answer session, which the students asked questions to the speaker and their query was replied by Ms. Neha Lal.
