Brief summary:

Clinical Nutrition and Dietetics is one of the major disciplines of nutrition and dietetics. An important career prospect of a clinical nutrition and dietetics student is working as a RD at a hospital. RD stands for Registered Dietitian, who is a qualified, skilled and knowledgeable professional. A Registered Dietitian is authorized to prescribe Medical Nutrition Therapy (MNT), which is evidence-based, and to counsel people to achieve and maintain good health. The RD title is a differentiator for quality advice for patients. The IDA Registration Board awards a registration number and certificate to applicants who successfully complete the registration examination after going through an intensive internship program designed by the RD Board which is on par with international standards. In view of this, the following online workshop on RD training has been proposed which will help students understand the standards and protocols pertaining to RD examination. The workshop was proposed to be in collaboration with Indian Dietetics Association (IDA), Pune Chapter who had different speakers from IDA team. The target audience included students of M.Sc. Nutrition and Dietetics Specialization: Clinical Nutrition and Dietetics.

Early Detection and Prevention:



Awareness and Education:


Screening allows for individualized risk assessment. Participants receive personalized guidance based on their blood pressure readings, empowering them to make informed decisions regarding their health.



Symbiosis Institute of Health Sciences (Medical Technology Department) organized a workshop on "Dialysis Technology- Recent Advances and Modalities" to impart knowledge and skills required to perform advanced therapies in dialysis like Continuous Renal Replacement Therapy (CRRT), Online- Hemo-diafiltration (Online-


HDF), to students of Dialysis Technology program on 8th October ,2022. The following points were discussed.

1. **Hemodialysis (HD) and Peritoneal Dialysis (PD) Innovations:**
 - **High-Flux Hemodialysis:** High-flux dialyzers allow for more efficient removal of waste products and toxins from the blood, leading to improved outcomes for patients.
 - **Daily Home Hemodialysis (DHD):** Some patients opt for more frequent, shorter HD sessions at home, which can provide better clearance and flexibility in treatment schedules.
 - **Synchronized Hemodialysis:** This approach aims to mimic the natural circadian rhythm of kidney function, potentially reducing the stress on the cardiovascular system.
 - **Automated Peritoneal Dialysis (APD):** APD machines have become more user-friendly and portable, making it easier for patients to perform peritoneal dialysis at home.
2. **Wearable and Portable Devices:**
 - There has been a trend toward developing wearable or portable dialysis machines, which can enhance mobility and allow patients to maintain a more active lifestyle while undergoing treatment.
3. **Improved Vascular Access:**
 - Advances in vascular access techniques, such as the creation of arteriovenous fistulas and grafts, have made it easier to provide efficient hemodialysis while reducing the risk of complications.
4. **Biocompatible Dialysis Solutions:**
 - The development of biocompatible dialysis fluids aims to reduce inflammation and complications during hemodialysis, improving overall patient comfort.
5. **Sorption-Based Dialysis:**
 - Sorbent-based systems are being researched as an alternative to traditional dialysis, using sorbent cartridges to remove toxins from the blood. These systems have the potential to provide more gentle and efficient treatment.
6. **Nanotechnology in Dialysis:**
 - Nanotechnology is being explored for the development of advanced dialysis membranes, which could improve the selectivity of dialysis and reduce complications.
7. **Telemedicine and Remote Monitoring:**
 - Telemedicine and remote monitoring technologies have become more prevalent, allowing healthcare providers to monitor patients' dialysis treatments and make adjustments as needed without requiring frequent in-person visits.
8. **Personalized Medicine Approaches:**
 - Personalized medicine and genomics are being integrated into dialysis care, with the goal of tailoring treatment plans to an individual patient's unique needs.
9. **Artificial Kidney Development:**
 - Research into the development of artificial kidneys, such as bioengineered or implantable devices, continues to advance. These devices aim to replicate the functions of natural kidneys more closely.

10. Regenerative Medicine:

- There is ongoing research into regenerative medicine approaches to repair and replace damaged kidney tissue, potentially reducing the need for long-term dialysis.







Summary Report

The heart's size and shape can reveal information about cardiac health, while assessing the diaphragm can help detect conditions like pleural effusions or pneumothorax. The chest X-ray, often used in conjunction with clinical history and other diagnostic tools, serves as a valuable tool for initial assessments and guiding further diagnostic and treatment decisions in patient care. Accurate interpretation is essential for delivering quality healthcare.


