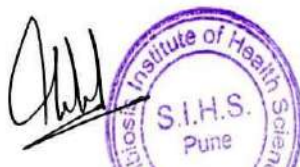

India, with an estimated population of 1.32 billion, has only one government allopathic doctor for average 10,926 persons 4 - 10 times higher than the WHO recommendation of 1:1000 people.

Some Indian states with the poorest health index, with a predominant rural population, have only one doctor serving up to 28,000 people (EAG states) - with a higher concentration of doctors in urban areas.

Only four states have more than the recommended HRH of 44.5 per 10,000 population in India. **While Delhi has the highest density of HRH of 67, Jharkhand has only 7 HRH per 10,000 persons.**

Concept Note

The demand for trained healthcare professionals in diagnostic modalities is growing as technology progresses. An ECG is often used along with other tests to help diagnose and monitor conditions affecting the heart. It is used to investigate symptoms of a possible heart problem, such as chest pain, palpitations, dizziness and shortness of breath. Thus, it is critical for allied healthcare personnel to be familiar with these ECG procedures and interpretation.



Anthropometry has a long tradition of assessing nutritional and health status of children and adults as this is an inexpensive, non-invasive method that provides detailed information on different components of body structure and growth, especially muscular and fat components. Moreover, anthropometric measurements are highly sensitive to the broad spectrum of nutritional status, whereas biochemical and clinical indicators are useful only at extremes of malnutrition. Among the widely used anthropometric measurements, body mass index (BMI) and mid-upper-arm-circumference (MUAC) are most significant and reliable.

Anthropometrics is the practice of taking measurements of the human body and provides categorised data that can be used by designers. It is important to use the correct anthropometric measure to assess the health of an individual. With the strides in the medical field, it is imperative that we understand the learn to take the correct measurements for different ages and disease states.

Rationale: With this workshop, we learned the traditional as well as the newer anthropometric measures we can employ in our routine practice for different ages (childhood, adults and geriatrics in community and clinical settings. This serves as a good career enhancement workshop for students of Nutrition department, SIHS.

Anthropometry has a long tradition of assessing nutritional and health status of children and adults as this is an inexpensive, non-invasive method that provides detailed information on different components of body structure and growth, especially muscular and fat components. Moreover, anthropometric measurements are highly sensitive to the broad spectrum of nutritional status, whereas biochemical and clinical indicators are useful only of extremes of malnutrition. Among the widely used anthropometric measurements, body mass index (BMI) and mid-upper-arm-circumference (MUAC) are most significant and reliable.

Anthropometrics is the practice of taking measurements of the human body and provides categorised data that can be used by designers. It is important to use the correct anthropometric measure to assess the health of an individual. With the strides in the medical field, it is imperative that we understand the learn to take the correct measurements for different ages and disease states.

Rationale: With this workshop, we propose to learn the traditional as well as the newer anthropometric measures we can employ in our routine practice for different ages (childhood, adults and geriatrics in community and clinical settings).
