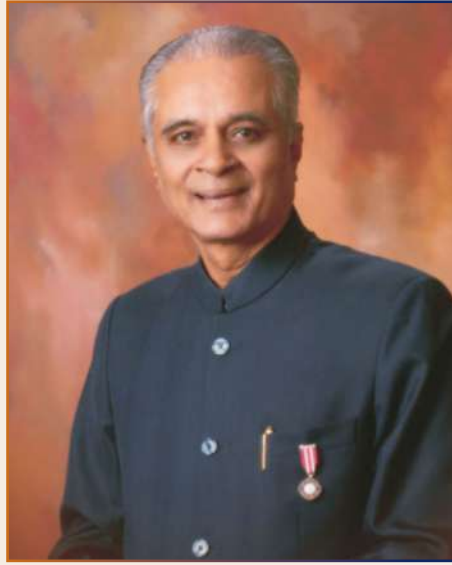

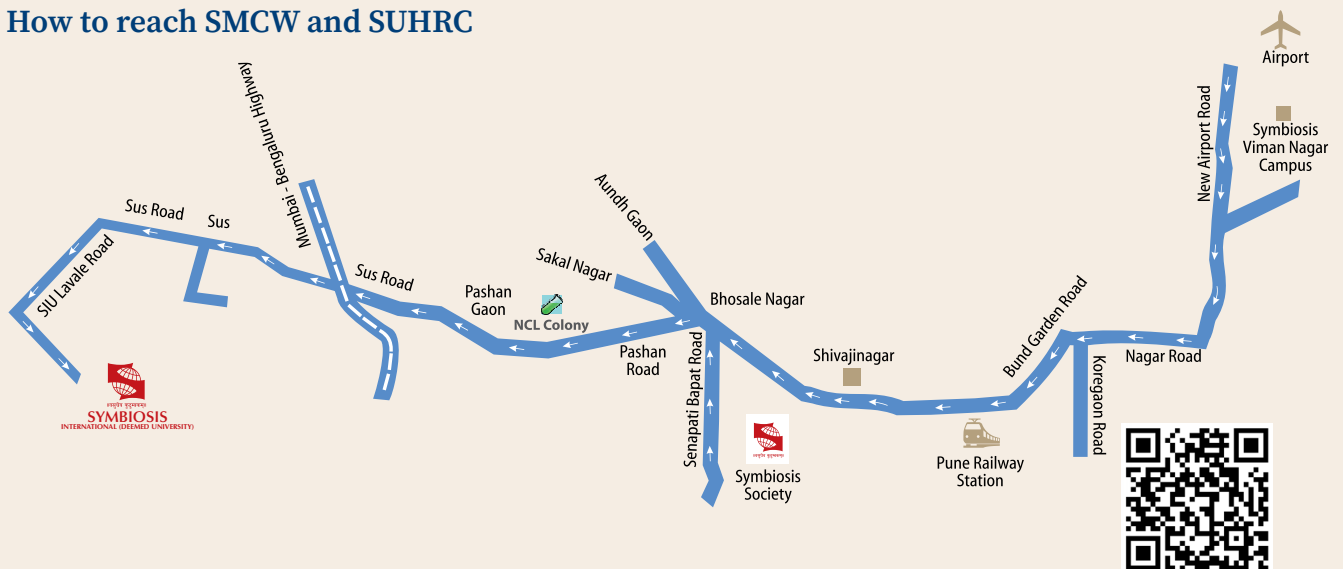

About Pune



Pune, the cultural and educational capital of the Indian State of Maharashtra is also known as ‘The Oxford of the East’ due to the presence of several well-known educational institutions. The city has emerged as a major educational hub in recent decades, with nearly half of the total international students in the country studying in Pune.

Pune, is a bustling metropolis with an estimated population of about 49 million spread over 114 sq. kms. It is situated at an altitude of 482 meters above sea level. It has been ranked as one of the most livable cities in India several times. The temperatures ranges from 10 °C to 38 °C with an average rainfall of 1185 cm.
